This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.116/2021 registered at Police Station Sangaria, Hanumangarh for offences under Section 408 of IPC, 1860.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and the allegation against him are pertaining to the year 2013-14 to 2018-19, whereas the FIR has been registered in the 2021, after a lapse of almost six years from the initial date. He further submits that the offences alleged against the petitioner are triable by Court of

Magistrate and the petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026. The investigation qua the petitioner stands complete and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the accused-petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned Additional Advocate General and learned counsel for the complainant have opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Additional Advocate General and perused the material available on record.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the offences are triable by Court of Magistrate, the investigation has been completed, no recovery is required to be made from the petitioner, continued incarceration of the petitioner is not warranted. The accused-petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 and conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time. Further, the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner absconding or tampering with the evidence if released on bail. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Vinod Kumar @ Vinod Choudhary S/o Shri Gharsi Ram** arrested in connection with FIR No.116/2021 registered at Police Station Sangaria, Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the



satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
