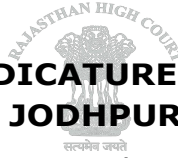

This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.95/2026 registered at Police Station Napasar, District Bikaner for offences under Sections 8, 22, 25 and 30 of the NDPS Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the contraband recovered is 14.13 grams MD has been recovered from the petitioner which is below commercial quantity. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.05.2026. He further submits that the criminal antecedents of the petitioner are cleared and co-accused namely Devesh, Karan Singh, Ramdev



and Jassu @ Jaswant have already been enlarged on bail by Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 02.06.2026 in S.B CRLMB Nos. 7024 of 2026, 6729 of 2026, 7025 of 2026 and 7026 of 2026 respectively and trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record. In the present case, the contraband recovered is 14.13 grams MD has been recovered from the petitioner which is below commercial quantity. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 10.05.2026. The criminal antecedents of the petitioner are cleared and co-accused namely Devesh, Karan Singh, Ramdev and Jassu @ Jaswant have already been enlarged on bail by Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 02.06.2026 in S.B CRLMB Nos. 7024 of 2026, 6729 of 2026, 7025 of 2026 and 7026 of 2026 respectively and the investigation/trial is likely to take sufficient long time to conclude. Hence, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is **allowed**. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Vishva Pareek S/o Murli Pareek**, arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.95/2026 registered at Police Station Napasar, District Bikaner, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of



Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
