This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.34/2026 registered at Police Station Kolayat, District Bikaner, for offences under Sections 318(4), 325, 61(2) of BNS and Section 4/8(2) of Rajasthan Bovine Animal Act,1995.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate and moreover he was not found at the place with the vehicle. He submits that he has only been enroped in the present case on the ground of the statement of the co-accused. He submits that in such circumstances he has been falsely implicated in the present case and pendency of the cases also

would not come. He further submits that after investigation *challan* has already filed in the present case and the petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.03.2026 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard the rival submissions and considered the facts and circumstances. The offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate and the petitioner was not found along with the vehicle when the same was seized. The co-accused persons namely *Sarwar @ Gullu and Zakir* have already been enlarged on bail by a co-ordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 15.05.2026 passed in *S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.4807/2026*.

Hence, keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Aarif S/o Babu**, arrested in connection with FIR No.34/2026 registered at Police Station Kolayat, District Bikaner, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to

the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
