This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioners who have been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.224/2026 registered at Police Station Sardarshahar, District Churu for offences under Sections 3 and 4 of Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinance, 1949 and Sections 112(2) and 318(4) of BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that the offences alleged against the petitioners are triable by Court of Magistrate and the petitioners have been in judicial custody since 29.05.2026. The investigation qua the

petitioners stand complete and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the accused-petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned Additional Advocate General has opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties perused the material available on record.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the offences are triable by Court of Magistrate, the investigation has been completed, no recovery is required to be made from the petitioners, continued incarceration of the petitioners is not warranted. There are two criminal cases registered against the petitioners, however, both of them are not of similar nature. The accused-petitioners have been in judicial custody since 29.05.2026 and conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time. Further, the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner absconding or tampering with the evidence if released on bail. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners **(1) Umaid Singh S/o Kishore Singh** and **(2) Pratap S/o Subhkaran** arrested in connection with FIR No.224/2026 registered at Police Station Sardarshahar, District Churu, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of

them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
