1. This instant application under Section 482 of BNSS is filed by the petitioner-applicant **Sampat Das Sadh S/o Shri Dula Das** for seeking anticipatory bail in event of arrest in connection with FIR No.482/2025 dated 22.12.2025 registered at P.S. Shri Dungargarh, District Bikaner, for alleged offence under Sections 318(4), 336(3), 338, 340(2), 339, 319(2), 322 and 61(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has falsely implicated in a concocted criminal case. He also submitted that the applicant may be arrested due to ulterior motive and to fulfill personal *vendetta* of complainant though

there is no evidence against the petitioner-applicant. He further submitted that the petitioner is a law abiding citizen having no previous criminal antecedents, but he assures full cooperation with Investigating Agency.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the complainant Jitendra Kumar has lodged a report against Lichhman Singh, Chandra Prakash, Heeralal and unknown persons, but the applicant was not named in the report. He also submits that the trial Court has dismissed the bail application only on the ground that present applicant is a kingpin, but there is no evidence to show that present applicant is anyway involved in fabrication of any document.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are grave and serious.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-applicant and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record submitted by both the parties.
6. On basis of report dated 22.12.2025 lodged by complainant Jitendra Kumar against Lichhman Singh, Chandra Prakash, Heeralal and unknown persons about execution of sale deed of their land on 10.11.2025 and further registration of 11.11.2025 on basis of forged documents, FIR No.482/2025 dated 22.12.2025 was registered at Police Station Shri Dungargarh, District Bikaner. The investigation suggests that forged Aadhar Card of Dalchand, Muli Devi, Jeevraj and Champalal were prepared and with impersonation of these persons, the sale deed was executed on 10.11.2025 and

registered on 11.11.2025. During investigation, police has found that present applicant is a kingpin and one of the main accused. The police has also arrested Bhanwar Lal and Mangi Lal who were in custody.

7. The material on record clearly indicate role and involvement of present applicant in the incident. The present applicant is one of the main accused who conspired for the entire transaction, therefore, considering the role and involvement of present applicant, he is not entitled to get anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS.
8. In view of discussion made herein above, the instant bail application under Section 482 of BNSS filed by **Sampat Das Sadh S/o Shri Dula Das** is hereby dismissed.
