In S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 10189/2016: -

The present matter comes upon an application for impleadment of the Secretary, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi and Tehsildar (Revenue), Hanumangarh as party respondent to the present writ petition.

For the reasons stated in the application the same is allowed.

The Secretary, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi and Tehsildar (Revenue), Hanumangarh are permitted to be impleaded as party respondents in the writ petition. The amended cause title as filed be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the petition on Mr. B.P. Bohra, counsel regularly appearing on

behalf of the Union of India and on Mr. Mrigraj Singh Rathore, counsel regularly appearing on behalf of Revenue Department.

Mr. Bohra and Mr. Rathore are directed to complete their instructions and file the reply to the petition within a period of three weeks.

In the present matter, two contrary communications have been placed on record issued by the Central Department. In the first communication dated 27.06.2001 it has been stated that 'Jat Sikh' community would be included in the Central list of backward classes and in the second communication dated 29.08.2016 addressed to the Bank it has been stated that the said community would not be included in the Central list of OBC. Therefore, the counsels are directed to file specific reply to the issue whether 'Jat Sikh' community would be included in the central list of OBC or not.

In S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 13984/2016: -

Vide order dated 11.01.2018, counsel for the petitioner was given liberty to serve a copy of the petition on Mr. B.P. Bohra, learned counsel for Union of India.
