The present habeas corpus petition has been filed alleging that corpus 'S' has been kept in illegal detention by private respondent Nos. 5 to 9.



This Court vide order dated 10.06.2026 directed the Investigating Officer to produce the corpus before the Court. In compliance of the Court's order dated 10.06.2026, the corpus was presented today before this Court by the concerned police officials.

On interaction with her in camera, the corpus candidly stated that she is residing with respondent No.5 out of her free will and volition. She also stated that she has not been illegally detained by anyone and has been residing with respondent No.5 happily. She empathetically stated that she does not wish to go to her father's place.

In view of the aforesaid factual situation and keeping in view the fact that corpus presented before this Court has clearly stated that she is residing with respondent No.5 happily out of her free will and volition and she is not in illegal detention of anyone, this Court finds no force in the present habeas corpus petition.

The same is accordingly, dismissed.
