Order

1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed by the applicants-accused **(1) Rakesh Kumar @ Prince S/o Sukh Ram** and **(2) Arpan @ Pinna Boxer S/o**

Bhagwana Ram seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.240/2026 dated 10.05.2026 registered at P.S. Anupgarh, District Sriganganagar, for the offence punishable under Sections 109(1) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and Section 27 of Arms Act.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submit that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. They further submit that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court and the applicants do not have any criminal antecedents. They also submit that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submit that the allegation is upon co-accused Riyasat Ali that he fired a shot from a firearm, but no one has got injured from the fire. He also submits that neither accused Rakesh nor Arpan were named in FIR and only on basis of certain statement and information of co-accused, present applicants were named as an accused. They also submit that both the applicants are in custody since their arrest.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 10.05.2026 lodged by Balwant Singh against Riyasat Ali and Rakesh @ Prince about incident of fire on 10.05.2026 FIR No.240/2026 was registered at Police Station Anupgarh, District Sriganganagar. Both the applicants were arrested on 13.05.2026 and since then, they are in custody. Main allegation is upon Riyasat. There is no criminal antecedent against Arpan, but two criminal cases were registered against Rakesh.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **(1) Rakesh Kumar @ Prince S/o Sukh Ram** and **(2) Arpan @ Pinna Boxer S/o Bhagwana Ram**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
