Order

1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Sita Ram Gat S/o Heera Ram** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.101/2026 dated 15.05.2026 registered at Police Station Napasar, District Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 331(4), 109(1), 115(2), 126(2), 324(4), 112(2), 307 & 189(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that for incident between 09.05.2026 to 12.05.2026 FIR was registered on 14.05.2026 wherein the main allegation is upon Ram Swaroop who allegedly driven a camper vehicle. He also submitted that there is no specific attribution of any of the injury or assault upon present applicant. He is custody since his arrest on 03.06.2026. He also submitted that except one other criminal case there is no other criminal case against the applicant-accused.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned counsel for complainant and learned Public Prosecutor. Learned counsel for complainant has submitted that there were two incident for which one FIR was registered and the act is to intimidate the complainant-party.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 14.05.2026 lodged by complainant- Balram against Ramswaroop Jat and five other named persons about incident of 09.05.2026 and 12.05.2026 FIR No. 101/2026 dated 15.05.2026 was registered at PS Napasar District Bikaner. During investigation present applicant-accused was arrested and he is in custody. The material on record clearly indicate that except one criminal case there is no other criminal

antecedents against the applicant-accused. Admittedly the injured have sustained simple injuries and main allegation is upon Ram Swaroop Jat.

7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Sita Ram Gat S/o Heera Ram**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
