- 1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **Kailash Gehlot @ Ballu S/o Sampatlal** and **Ganesh Gehlot S/o Kailash** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No. 105/2026 dated 20.04.2026 registered at P.S. Gangashahar, District Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 115(2), 304(2), 74, 3(5) BNS.
- 2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the

investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. She further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. She also submits that the applicants undertake not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for applicants submits that due to an alleged attempt to theft electricity by directly connecting to main line, a scuffle has occurred between both the parties who are closely related to each other. She further submitted that except one injury upon Shiv, all injuries are simple in nature upon all injured and the injury upon Shiv is not on vital part. She further submitted that both the applicants are in custody since their arrest on 28.05.2026 and police has already filed a charge sheet.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicants-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 24.04.2026 lodged by complainant Monika W/o Shiv Gehlot against five named persons about alleged assault on 28.04.2026, FIR No. 105/2026 was registered at P.S. Gangashahar, District Bikaner. During investigation, both the applicants were arrested on 28.05.2026 and after investigation, a charge-sheet has already been filed. We have considered the injury

report of Shiv, Baby and Yogesh except one injury upon Shiv, all are simple in nature. The injury upon Shiv in on vital part. There is no criminal antecedents against each of the applicants.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Kailash Gehlot @ Ballu S/o Sampatlal** and **Ganesh Gehlot S/o Kailash**, is hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- by each of them with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
