This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.128/2026 registered at Police Station, Pilbanga, District Hanumangarh for the offence under Sections 318(4), 308(2), 308(6), 316(2), 61(2)(A) of BNS, 2023.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation of taking money is on co-accused Sandeep, who has already been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 27.4.2026 in S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.5075/2026. The petitioner is a lady. More so, the offences alleged are triable by Magistrate and there is only one case shown to be pending against the petitioner under BNS offences. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 11.05.2026 and the trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor as well as counsel for the complainant opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; co-accused Sandeep has already been enlarged on bail by this Court; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case she is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Fulan Devi Ahirwar Urf Shivani Sharma Urf Suani W/o Shri Prakash** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.128/2026 registered at Police Station, Pilbanga, District Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided she furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for her appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
