JUSTICE ANOOP KUMAR DHAND

Order

1. The instant writ petition has been preferred against the
impugned auction notice dated 25.05.2026 issued by the Sub-
Divisional Officer, Ahore, District Jalore in pursuance of the
directions issued by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sirohi
vide order/award dated 14.06.2022 while deciding the Motor
Accident Claim No.51/2019.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that before issuing the aforesaid impugned auction notice, no opportunity of hearing was provided to the petitioner and now the Sub-Divisional Officer, Ahore is bent upon to auction off the land belong to the petitioner, hence, interference of this Court is warranted.

3. Heard and considered the submissions made at the Bar and perused the material available on the record.

4. Perusal of the record indicates that a claim petition was filed by the claimants under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 against the petitioner before the MACT, Sirohi. The said claim petition allowed by the Tribunal while passing the award dated 14.06.2022 and a direction has also been issued to the petitioner to pay compensation amount to the claimants.

5. Thereafter, since the award passed by the Tribunal was not complied with by the petitioner, hence under these circumstances, the execution petition has been submitted by the claimants before the Tribunal and as a consequence thereof, the proceedings under the Rajasthan Land Revenue Act (Land Records), 1957 has been initiated against the petitioner by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Ahore for satisfying the award dated 14.06.2022 passed by the Tribunal by issuing the impugned auction notice for attachment of the land belonging to the petitioner.

6. This Court finds no illegality in the aforesaid auction notice, hence, interference of this Court is not warranted.

7. With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of. Stay application as well as all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
