1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Rajat Khan S/o Shri Sanjay Khan** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.177/2026 dated 29.04.2026 registered at Police Station Sadar Ganganagar, District Sri Ganganagar, for the offence under Sections 64(2)(m), 140(3) & 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and under Sections 3, 4(1), 5I and 6(1) of POCSO Act, 2012 (Amended 2019).
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are

no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that a false report was registered by a 20 years old prosecutrix and the allegation as mentioned in the report clearly indicate that the prosecutrix has voluntarily kept relation with present applicant-accused. He also submitted that prosecutrix herself is present before this Hon'ble Court and she has entered into a compromise with present applicant-accused and same is placed on record. He also submitted that the prosecutrix has no objection in case bail is granted.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and he submitted that charges are grave and serious. Learned counsel for complainant submits that victim herself is present before this Court and she is an adult female as on date and she has no objection in case bail is granted. He further acknowledged the factum of submission of compromise before the Court.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 29.04.2026 lodged by a 20 years old prosecutrix (victim) for incident between 25.12.2023 to 29.04.2026 FIR No. 177/2026 was registered at Police Station Sadar Ganganagar, District Sri Ganganagar and during investigation present applicant-accused was arrested

by police on 24.05.2026 and since then he is in custody. The victim herself is present before this Court and she submits she does not want any action against the present applicant-accused and she has no objection in case bail is granted to the applicant-accused. The victim is a 20 years old female and even on 10.10.2023 her age was more than 16 years.

7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Rajat Khan S/o Shri Sanjay Khan**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
