This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.313/2026 registered at Police Station Pilibanga, District Hanumangarh for offences under Sections 8/21 of the NDPS Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further contended that 31.55 gram smack (heroin/chitta) has been recovered from the petitioner which is below commercial quantity. Learned counsel submitted that no case under NDPS Act is registered against him and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.05.2026 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long

time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record. In the present case, the contraband recovered is 31.55 gram smack (heroin/chitta) which is below commercial quantity. Further, the investigation of the petitioners is complete and his antecedents are clear; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is behind the bars since 21.05.2026 and the investigation/trial is likely to take sufficient long time to conclude. Hence, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Sukhchain Singh S/o Shri Gurmej Singh** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.313/2026 registered at Police Station Pilibanga, District Hanumangarh shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
