1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **Ishwar Singh S/o Narpat Singh & Shishpal Singh S/o Narpat Singh**, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.89/2026 dated 23.02.2026 registered at P.S. Sridungargarh, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 109(1), 331(6), 115(2), 126(2), 307 and 189(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that for incident of 22.02.2026, a report was registered on 23.02.2026 wherein a specific allegation is made against Narpat Singh. He further referred the statement & the Police investigation and submitted that the injured has sustained only one injury and the allegation is upon Narpat Singh. He submitted that identically placed person Sher Singh was granted bail by Co-ordinate Bench on 21.04.2026, and appellants are seeking bail on ground of parity.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On complaint lodged by Ajit Singh against seven named persons about incident of 22.02.2026, FIR No.89/2026 was registered at Police Station Sridungargarh, District Bikaner on 23.02.2026. Both the appellants were arrested on 22.05.2026 but the main allegation is upon Narpat Singh. Co-accused Sher Singh was granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench on 21.04.2026. Considering the allegation as made in the statement of injured and others, it is appropriate to consider the bail application of both the applicants Ishwar Singh S/o Narpat Singh and Shishpal Singh S/o Narpat Singh, in parity with Sher Singh.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Ishwar Singh S/o Narpat Singh & Shishpal Singh S/o Narpat Singh**, are hereby allowed and the applicant-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
