These applications for bail under Section 483 of BNSS have been filed by the petitioners who have been arrested in connection with order dated 26.05.2026 passed in Case No.185 (Book No.185 Page No.22/2024) registered by Regional Forest Officer, Chhayana, District Jaisalmer for the offences punishable under Sections 9, 51, 39, 48-A & 49-B of Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the offences pressed against the petitioners are triable by the Court of Magistrate. It is further contended that the allegation levelled against them of hunting are false and frivolous and they have been falsely implicated in the present matters. It is further submitted that petitioner Kishan Nath and Narayanram are in judicial custody since 21.05.2026 and 20.05.2026 respectively and the investigation against them is complete. The trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioners.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail applications.

This Court has considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case. The offences pressed against the petitioners are triable by the Court of Magistrate. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 21.05.2026 and 20.05.2026 respectively and the investigation against them is complete.

Hence, keeping in view of the fact that the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate; conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioners fleeing away from justice, in case they enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, these bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners No. **1. Kishan Nath S/o Roomal Nath and 2. Narayanram S/o Tejaram**, arrested in connection with Case No.185 (Book No.185 Page No.22/2024) registered by Regional Forest Officer, Chhayan, District Jaisalmer shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
