This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.126/2026 registered at Police Station, Surajpole, District Udaipur for the offence under Sections 11(2)(B), 111(3), 111(4) of BNS, 2023 and under Sections 3/25, 25(6), 5/25 of Arms Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that apart from the offence under Section 111 BNS, 2023 all the offences are triable by Magistrate. It is submitted that from co-accused Faijal & Chandrapal Singh country-made Pistol; and from accused-Taha one mobile phone is stated to have been recovered. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioner. Furthermore, all the co-accused persons, namely, Faijal, Chandrapal Singh and Taha have been enlarged on bail by this Court vide orders dated 13.5.2026, 14.5.2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.4.2026 and the trial of case will take a

sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; co-accused Faijal, Chandrapal Singh and Taha have been enlarged on bail by this Court; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Arbaz Alias Najim Alias Lala** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.126/2026 registered at Police Station, Surajpole, District Udaipur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
