1. Mr. S.S. Ladrecha, learned Additional Advocate General submitted that the petitioner No.2 is the Principal of one of the two government B.Ed Colleges run by the State Government in the entire State.
2. He submitted that when the Appellate Authority heard petitioners' appeal, it was brought to its notice that sufficient teaching staff had already been deployed, yet, the Appellate Authority instead of considering the same has rejected petitioners' appeal, merely on the ground that sufficient staff for B.Ed. And M.Ed. Course was not available.
3. Learned Additional Advocate General submitted that for B.Ed. and M.Ed. Course, the requisite teachers have been selected from amongst the State Government employees, who are otherwise qualified to teach B.Ed/M.Ed. and further submitted that the process of regular recruitment for faculties in the government colleges is already underway.
4. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.
5. Meanwhile, effect and operation of the orders dated 02.06.2025 (Annexure-1) and 23.01.2024 (Annexure-2) shall remain stayed and the Institute of Advanced Studies in Education, Bikaner shall be allowed to take part in the ongoing counseling for B.Ed. and M.Ed. Courses.
