This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.196/2024 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Nagaur for the offences under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 120-B of IPC.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is only stated to be witness of the power of attorney that too was executed between father and son. He further submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 27.05.2026 and the trial

of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Vinod Kumar S/o Shri Brijlal**, arrested in connection with FIR No. 196/2024 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Nagaur shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
