S.B. Criminal Misc.Bail Application No. 8218/2026 :-

Counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant bail application.

Accordingly, this bail application filed by **Santu Ram S/o Prempal** is dismissed as not pressed.

S.B. Criminal Misc.Bail Application No. 7227/2026 :-

This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.21/2026 registered at Police Station, Loonkaransar, District Bikaner for the offence under Sections 318(2), 340(2), 338, 336(3), 61(2) of BNS, 2023.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is alleged to have helped in forging 'patta' and taking loan against it. The offences pressed against him are triable by Magistrate. He is behind bars since 24.5.2026 and trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not

shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Vijay Verma S/o Shri Palaram** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.21/2026 registered at Police Station, Loonkaransar, District Bikaner, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.

S.B. Criminal Misc.Bail Application No. 8230/2026 :-

This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.21/2026 registered at Police Station, Loonkaransar, District Bikaner for the offence under Sections 318(2), 340(2), 338, 336(3), 61(2) of BNS, 2023.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences pressed against him are triable by Magistrate. Further the allegations against him are that he stood as a guarantor in the loan alleged to have been taken on behalf of complainant's mother. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.
