1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner who claims to be live in partner of the corpus Mst. 'D'

alleging therein that she is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'D' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'D'. The corpus Mst. 'D' has stated that she is 30 years of age and understands her well-being quite well. She has further stated that she wants to go and live with her children in Gujarat and has flatly refused to accompany the petitioner. The corpus Mst. 'D' has also stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including the private respondents.

5. We have considered the statements made before us and we find that the corpus Mst. 'D' is a major married lady, capable of taking decisions in her best interests and she is not in illegal detention of any person including the private respondents.

6. In view of the discussion made above, the present habeas corpus petition fails and the same is hereby dismissed.

7. The Investigating Agency is directed to allow the corpus Mst. 'D' to live at a place and with a person of her choice. The Investigating Agency is further directed to provide adequate security to the corpus Mst. 'D' till she reaches of a place of her choice.

8. The amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the petitioner under the directions issued by this Court stands forfeited.
