1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the order dated 24.02.2026 passed by this Court in SBCWP No.4705/2026 : "*Shyam Lal Khadav v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*"; wherein, notices were issued and interim relief was granted to the petitioner. The said order is reproduced hereunder:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in similar controversy arising out of the fact that the headquarter of the petitioner has been changed vide impugned order during the course of his suspension, which is contrary to the law laid down by this Court in the case of **Subhash Chandra Vs. State of**

Rajasthan & Ors.: SBCWP No.10353/2021 decided on 03.09.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the petitioner has been placed under suspension vide order dated 20.02.2026 (Annex-1) and the headquarter of the petitioner has been changed from Jaitaran to Tonk. He further submits that, in such posting, the district-level seniority of the petitioner is maintained at the district level.

Issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of stay petition as well.

In the meanwhile and until further orders, the effect and operation of the order dated 20.02.2026 (Annexure-1) shall remain stayed qua the direction in the said order changing the headquarter of the petitioner from Jaitran to Tonk."

2. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of stay petition as well.
3. In the meanwhile and until further orders, the effect and operation of the order dated 20.05.2026 (Annexure-2) shall remain stayed qua the direction in the said order changing the headquarter of the petitioner from Bhilwara to Nagaur.
4. Connect with SBCWP Nos.4705/2026 & 12448/2026, as prayed.
