The present applications for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) have been filed by the applicants arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.05/2026 registered at Police Station Cyber District Jodhpur, for offences under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 317(4), 316(2) and 61(2) of BNS and 66C, 66D IT Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate further the investigation from them is complete and the charge-sheet has already been filed. It is stated the co-accused Akshay Singh has already been enlarged on bail by learned trial Court and the petitioners are in judicial custody since 04.04.2026 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record. The investigation from petitioners has been completed and the charge-sheet has already been filed. It is stated the co-accused Akshay Singh has already been enlarged on bail by learned trial Court and the petitioners are in judicial custody since 04.04.2026

Hence, considering the facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner

Bhajan Lal S/o Shri Sriram and **Dhanraj S/o Bhagirath**

arrested in connection with FIR No.05/2026 registered at Police Station Cyber District Jodhpur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
