1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Dheeraj Singh Rajpurohit @ Gopal S/o Jagdish Prasad Rajpurohit** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.206/2025 dated 21.06.2025 registered at P.S. Gangashahar, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 of IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that for incidents between 26.01.2024 to 25.02.2025 the complainant Jetharam Suthar has lodged a Police report on the basis of a criminal complaint before the Criminal Court. He also submitted that the incidents mentioned by complainant clearly indicate that he voluntarily entered into a financial transaction with present applicant. He also submitted that the applicant is not having any money to return to complainant and the complainant has lodged the report barely on the ground that the applicant has forged the documents and misrepresented himself to secure loan from the financial institutions. He also submitted that the offence is triable by Magistrate First Class. He further referred order dated 26.05.2026 and submitted that present applicant was granted bail in FIR No.309/2025. He also submitted that now a charge-sheet has already been filed against the applicant.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of criminal complaint filed before the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate No.4, Bikaner FIR No.206/2025 was registered at Police Station Gangashahar, District Bikaner for offence under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC. Present

applicant was arrested on 11.03.2026 and a charge-sheet has already been filed against him. One more criminal case as FIR No.309/2025 was registered at Police Station Kotgate, District Bikaner wherein petitioner was granted bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 26.05.2026. The Police investigation report suggests that the petitioner has worked and impersonated himself as a loan agent to different banks and he committed offence of cheating with complainant Jetharam Suthar. The offence is triable by Magistrate First Class.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Dheeraj Singh Rajpurohit @ Gopal S/o Jagdish Prasad Rajpurohit**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.

- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
