This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.0097/2026 registered at Police Station Raisinghnagar, District Sri Ganganagar, for offences under Sections 8/21 and 29 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the contraband recovered is of 5.70 grams of smack and the same is of below commercial quantity. Learned counsel further submits that the same is recovered from the co-accused Priyanka Rathi who has already been enlarged on bail by coordinate bench of this Court in SBCRLMBA No. 4102/2026 and she has been falsely implicated and has no previous criminal antecedents. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.06.2026 and the trial of the case will take

sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Having heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record; considering the fact that the narcotic contraband recovered in this case is below commercial quantity; the petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.06.2026 and the contraband is recovered from the co-accused who has already been enlarged on bail; the investigation/trial will take sufficient time to conclude; without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Savitri Devi Alias Sunita W/o Ishar Ram** arrested in connection with FIR No.0097/2026 registered at Police Station Rai Singh Nagar, District Sri Ganganagar, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
