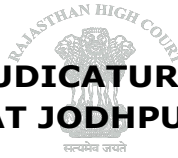

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner – Dala Ram, who claims himself to be the live-in-partner of the corpus Mst. 'H'. It is alleged that the corpus Mst. 'H' is in illegal detention of the respondent No.5.
3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'H' is produced before this Court.
4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'H'. She stated that she is a major lady of 26 years of age, who understands her well being quite well. She stated that this is second time, when she has



been called before this court. In the earlier round of habeas corpus petition filed by the petitioner, she was appeared before this Court and stated that she wants to go and live with the present petitioner only, however, once again, at the instance of her parents and respondent No.5, she has been forced to come before this Court. She once again reiterated her earlier stand and stated that she is living with the present petitioner of her own free will without any pressure from any side. She further stated that her parents and her brother are harassing her for no reason.

5. We have considered the statements made before us by the corpus Mst. 'H' and we note that in the earlier habeas corpus petition filed by the petitioner, this court vide order dated 13.01.2026³ has passed a detailed order, wherein the corpus expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner and once again the corpus Mst. 'H' has appeared before this Court and expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner only.

6. In view of the statements made before this Court, the present Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of and the investigating agency is directed to allow the corpus Mst. 'H' to go and live with the present petitioner.

7. It is directed that the amount deposited by the present petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 02.07.2026 shall be refunded to the petitioner forthwith.
