Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court, vide order dated 16.04.2025, granted interim protection to the petitioners in CRLMP No. 3027/2025. He further submits that, pursuant to the said order, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer on the subsequent dates and have cooperated with the investigation by furnishing all the relevant documents. However, despite the same, the Investigating Officer has continued to harass the petitioners.

He further submits that no offence is made out against the petitioners. It is also contended that the allegations in the FIR regarding withdrawal of the amount are wholly false, and the documents substantiating the said contention have already been placed on record.

He further submits that, despite the interim protection granted by this Court, the Investigating Officer is proceeding to file the challan. In these circumstances, the petitioners have been

constrained to file a fresh petition, being CRLMP No. 4836/2026, which is listed along with the present petition today.

In view of the above, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter and hence the petitioners deserves further protection.

Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to call for the case diary on the next date of hearing.

List the matter on 20.07.2026.

Meanwhile, till the next date of hearing, no result in the present case shall be filed.

Interim order, in CRLMP No.3027/2025, shall continue till the next date of hearing.
