The present criminal misc. petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 BNSS for quashing of FIR No.87/2026, registered at Police Station Jaitpur, District Pali for offences under Sections 64(1), 127(4) and 115(2) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present FIR has been registered under the pressure exerted by the parents of the prosecutrix. It is submitted that the petitioner had twice filed Habeas Corpus Petitions on the ground that the prosecutrix had been forcibly taken away by her parents. In both the Habeas Corpus Petitions, bearing No. 359/2026 and No. 31/2026, the prosecutrix specifically stated that she was residing with the petitioner in a live-in relationship and had expressed her desire to accompany him. The petitioner further states that the

prosecutrix is presently residing with him and that he would file an appropriate application seeking quashing of the FIR. It is, therefore, contended that the very registration of the FIR is unsustainable in the eyes of law.

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accept notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.2, returnable within six weeks.

In the meanwhile, till the next date of hearing further proceeding in connection with FIR No.87/2026, registered at Police Station Jaitpur, District Pali shall remain stayed. However, petitioner shall join investigation.
