1. The present second bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Kayam @ Migan S/o Shri Bhupender** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No. 130/2026 dated 05.04.2026 registered at Police Station Jawahar Nagar, District Sri Ganganagar, for the offence under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 189(2) & 109(1) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant-accused is named in FIR but no specific role and assignment is made either in FIR or in the statement of injured. He also submitted that both the injured have not suffered any life threatening injury on any of the vital parts. He also submitted that there is no criminal antecedents against the applicant-accused and applicant-accused is in custody since his arrest on 30.05.2026.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for complainant and they submitted that the offence is serious in nature and role and involvement of applicant is established from the material on record.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 05.04.2026 lodged on the basis of *Parcha-bayan* of Sunny FIR No. 130/2026 was registered at Police Station Jawahar Nagar, District Sri Ganganagar about incident happened on night of 04.04.2026. Both the injured-Vikas and Sunny have suffered several injuries and the medical report indicate that injury No. 3 and 4 were found as grievous in respect of Vikas but both were caused by blunt weapon whereas injury No. 7, 10, 11, 13 and 15 were opined as grievous in nature in respect of Sunny all these

grievous injuries are on non-vital parts. There is no criminal antecedents against the applicant-accused. The allegation is upon a group of individuals laid by Amit Valmiki who is main accused in the instant case.

7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the second bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Kayam @ Migan S/o Shri Bhupender**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
