The present second bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.109/2025 registered at Police Station Bagri Nagar, District pali for offences under Sections 331(4), 331(8), 310(2), 109, 115(2) and 111(4) of BNS, 2023.

Earlier first bail application was dismissed as not pressed by this Court vide order dated 20.05.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.5604/2026, however, liberty was granted to file fresh bail application after filing of the *challan*. Now *challan* has already been filed in this matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during investigation, police has recovered respective ornaments alleged to have been looted by petitioner from the mother of the

complainant. Learned counsel further submits that recovery has already been effected. Charge-sheet has been filed. He further submits that co-accused Lalit Kumar, Vikash, Omprakash and Devendra @ TD have already been enlarged on bail by Coordinate Bench of this Court in Crlmb Nos.11136/2025, 10009/2025, 10027/2025 and 14815/2025 vide orders dated 04.11.2025 and 17.12.2025. The petitioner is behind the bars since 08.04.2026. Trial of the case is likely to take a long time. In view thereof, counsel prayed that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has strongly opposed the second bail application on the ground that the allegations against the present petitioner is of serious nature as he entered into the complainant's house and looted gold and silver ornaments from 70 years old lady, who also suffered injury during the said loot incident, therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to be released on bail.

Heard learned counsel for the parties perused the material available on record.

This Court considered the fact that charge-sheet has been filed as well as recovery has already been effected, co-accused have been enlarged on bail by Coordinate Bench of this Court and trial of the case is likely to take a sufficiently long time. In view thereof, this Court is inclined to enlarge the present petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the second bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Kushal S/o Mishrilal @ Mahesh** arrested in connection with FIR No.109/2025 registered at Police Station Bagri

Nagar, District Pali, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
