This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.120/2026 registered at Police Station Guda Endla, District Pali, for offences under Sections 8/15 and 8/18 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case recovery was made from the petitioner of 16.466 Kgs of 'Doda-Chura' as well as 211 grams of Opium Milk and the same has been recovered at a restaurant. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and there is no other case pending against him and that the contraband recovered is also below commercial quantity.

Moreover, Learned counsel submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.03.2026 and the trial of the case will take

sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Having heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record. Considering the fact that the narcotic contraband recovered in this case is below commercial quantity and that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.03.2026 and the present recovery is made from the petitioner of 16.66 Kgs of 'Doda-Chura' as well as 211 grams of Opium Milk, the investigation/trial will take sufficient time to conclude. Without expressing any opinion on the merits or demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Premkumar S/o Mahesh** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.120/2026 registered at Police Station Guda Endla, District Pali, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
