This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.324/2025 registered at Police Station Savina, District Udaipur, for offences under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate furthermore, the amount was received by the co-accused Anil who has already been enlarged on bail by co-ordinate bench of this Court in **S.B. CRLMBA No.14412/2025** vide order dated 06.12.2025 and petitioner is behind the since 02.05.2025, investigation from petitioner is complete and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record. The amount was received by the co-accused Anil who has already been enlarged on bail by co-ordinate bench of this Court in **S.B. CRLMBA No.14412/2025** dated 06.12.2025 and petitioner is behind the since 02.05.2025, investigation from petitioner is complete

Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; and that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Manish S/o Kanti Bhai** arrested in connection with FIR No.324/2025 registered at Police Station Savina, District Udaipur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
