1. Heard on interim stay application.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the impugned order of termination dated 31.01.2026 has been passed without informing the petitioner of the allegations which constitute the foundation of the said order. It is contended that neither the allegations nor the material/documents relied upon by the respondents were ever furnished to the petitioner before passing the impugned order, thereby depriving the petitioner of an effective opportunity of hearing.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and upon perusal of the material available on record, this Court is prima facie satisfied that the allegations forming the basis of the

impugned termination order, as also the documents relied upon in support thereof, were not disclosed to the petitioner before the order came to be passed. The petitioner appears to have been denied a reasonable opportunity to controvert the allegations and place his defence on record.

4. Prima facie, therefore, the action of the respondents suffers from violation of the principles of natural justice. Therefore, **there shall be stay on the impugned termination order dated 31.01.2026** till the final disposal of the present writ petition.

5. It is also directed that in case, the services of the petitioner are discontinued, he shall be permitted to join back his duties.

6. Issue notice to the respondent(s), returnable in four weeks.

7. List this matter after three weeks along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.1482/2026.
