This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.119/2026 registered at Police Station Degana, District Nagaur for offences under Sections 19, 20/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate. Learned counsel submits that the investigation has been completed and recovery has already been done. He further submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.06.2026 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long

time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view of the fact that the offences are triable by Magistrate, conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Gopalsingh S/o Kansingh**, arrested in connection with FIR No.119/2026 registered at Police Station Degana, District Nagaur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
