This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.196/2026 registered at Police Station Nokha, District Bikaner for offences under Sections 8/22 & 29 of the NDPS Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the contraband recovered in the present case is 6.19 gram MDMA (Mephedrone). It is further contended that no recovery has been made from the petitioner and the offence pressed against him are under Section 8/29 of NDPS Act. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and he is in judicial custody since 11.06.2026; the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record. In the present case, the contraband recovered is 6.19 gram MDMA (Mephedrone) which is below commercial quantity. Further the antecedents of the petitioner are clear as there is no case registered against him. Further, the investigation of the petitioner is complete and nothing is to be recovered from him and he is behind the bars since 11.06.2026 and the investigation/trial is likely to take sufficient long time to conclude. Hence, without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Anand Alias Puli S/o Ashok Kumar**, arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.196/2026 registered at Police Station Nokha, District Bikaner shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
