This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.13/2024 registered at Police Station Cyber, District Sri Ganganagar, for offences under Sections 318(4), 336(2), 338, 340(2) and 61(2)(a) of BNS and Section 43, 66(c)(d) of the IT Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences pressed against the petitioner are triable by Magistrate. It is further alleged that he procured forged Diploma in Civil Engineering from the University. It is further contended that in the FIR of the University of alleged hacking of the website, the alleged incident came to light. He further submitted that petitioner himself is a victim and he is behind the bars since 08.06.2026 and the



investigation from the petitioner is complete; and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard the rival submissions and considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by Court of Magistrate and he is in judicial custody since 08.06.2026. Keeping in view the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take sufficient long time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Lovekush S/o Shri Madan Lal Pachory** arrested in connection with FIR No.13/2024 registered at Police Station Cyber, District Sri Ganganagar, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
