Order

1. Matter comes upon an application (No. 1/26) filed on behalf of the petitioners, praying that the present writ petition having been heard on 09.07.2026 after hearing both parties has been reserved for judgment.
2. It is submitted that the next date before the trial Court is 17.07.2026 and the trial Court is proceeding further with the case. Therefore, in order to avoid any contradiction, the petitioners seek directions to defer the trial proceedings until the judgment in the present petition is pronounced.
3. For the reasons and grounds mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. It is ordered that, until the writ petitions mentioned above are decided, the learned trial Judge shall not proceed further with the proceedings. The writ petitions have already been reserved for pronouncement of judgment.

4. Indisputably, the challenge in the aforesaid writ petitions is to the order dated 27.05.2026 passed by the learned District Judge (Family Court), Sirohi, whereby the application filed by the plaintiff under Section 60 of the Indian Evidence Act was allowed.

5. In the instant matter, it is ordered that, until the judgment in the writ petitions mentioned above is pronounced, the learned trial Judge shall not proceed further with the proceedings. The matter is reserved for pronouncement of the order.
