This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.280/2020 registered at Police Station, Sanchore, District Jalore for the offence under Section 8/17, 25, and 29 of NDPS Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegedly recovered contraband substance (i.e. 800 Grams of Opium) is below commercial quantity. His antecedents are clear. The petitioner is behind bars since 09.06.2026. The trial of case will take a sufficiently long time, therefore, benefit of bail may be granted to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; recovery being below commercial quantity; antecedents of petitioner being clear; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Bhairulal S/o Shri Mangilal** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.280/2020 registered at Police Station, Sanchore, District Jalore shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
