This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.156/2023 registered at Police Station Pallu, District Hanumangarh, for offences under Sections 420, 406, 471, 482 and 120-B of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate and the down payment has already paid by him and petitioner is behind the bars since 25.05.2026. He submits that dispute *inter se* between the petitioner and the complainant is regarding the vehicle and investigation qua petitioner is complete and the trial of the case will take sufficiently

long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record. The down payment have already paid by him and petitioner is behind the bars since 25.05.2026. He submits that dispute *inter se* between the petitioner and the complainant is regarding the vehicle and investigation from him is complete.

Having considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Shakti Singh S/o Amarsingh Rajput** arrested in connection with FIR No.156/2023 registered at Police Station Pallu, District Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every
