Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in the present case, on a similar set of facts, a complaint was lodged before the police authorities, who, upon inquiry, found that no forgery had been committed. Thereafter, despite the said finding, the learned Magistrate directed registration of an FIR. He further submits that, in view of the aforesaid circumstances, there was no justification for the registration of the FIR. It is further contended that the dispute between the parties is purely civil in nature, as is evident from the police report dated 17.03.2026, which has been placed on record.

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within two weeks.



Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Mr. Ramdev Rajpurohit accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to call for the factual report on the next date of hearing.

List the matter on 24.07.2026.

Meanwhile, till the next date of hearing, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with the FIR No.96/2026 registered at Police Station Jaisalmer District Jaisalmer. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.
