This second bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioners who have been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.50/2026 registered at Police Station Sheo, District Barmer for offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 331(4), 305(A) and 307 of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners are triable by court of Magistrate. Learned counsel further submits that after thorough investigation, challan has already been filed and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioners.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the offences are triable by Court of Magistrate, the investigation has been completed, no recovery is required to be made from the petitioners, continued incarceration of the petitioners are not warranted. So far as the antecedents are already concerned, it is stated that in all cases, the petitioners are on bail. The accused-petitioners are in judicial custody since 16.03.2026 and conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time. The challan has already been filed. Further, the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioners absconding or tampering with the evidence if released on bail. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners **Kishan Singh S/o Punjraj Singh and Bhom Singh S/o Jai Singh** arrested in connection with FIR No.50/2026 registered at Police Station Sheo, Barmer, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided they furnish a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that



court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
