1. Considered submissions of learned counsel for petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is charged for committing an offence under Section 143 of Railway Act which is a bailable offence but RPF Sri Ganganagar is adamant to arrest the petitioner despite the fact that the offence is bailable. He further referred the order dated 02.06.2026 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, (WAC), Bikaner and submitted that during course of argument, it has been pointed out to learned Additional Sessions Judge (WAC) that one of the accused in the instant case was arrested by police and was kept behind bar for a period of 2 days, thus, the petitioner is under an apprehension that contrary to the provision of law, the petitioner be arrested by police and he be treated in similar manner and same has forced the petitioner to file current application under Section 482 of BNSS.

3. Having considered the submissions and also the material placed on record it is appropriate to call concerned SHO along with case diary.

5. In the meanwhile, no coercive step be taken against the petitioner.
