This application for bail under Section 483 of the BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 33/2026 registered at Police Station GRP, Jodhpur, District Jodhpur, for the offences punishable under Section 8/18 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in the present case, the contraband allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner is 253 grams of opium, which is below the commercial quantity prescribed under the NDPS Act. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and that no further recovery is to be effected from him.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 04.06.2026 and that the conclusion of the

trial is likely to take a considerable period of time. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard the rival submissions, considered the facts and circumstances of the case, as well as perused the material available on record. The alleged contraband of 253 grams of opium recovered from the petitioner is below the commercial quantity prescribed under the NDPS Act. The petitioner has remained in judicial custody since 04.06.2026. The antecedents of the petitioner are clear. The investigation/trial will take sufficient time to conclude. Hence, without expressing any opinion on the merits or demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Suresh Puri S/o Gotam Puri** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.33/2026 registered at Police Station Jodhpur, District GRP Jodhpur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
