1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that instant petition can be disposed of with the liberty to file a representation within a period of seven days **in light of Pawan Meena vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (SBCWP No. 1665/2024)** and Circular

issued by the Chief Secretary for the State of Rajasthan, dated 19.02.2024 (No. प. 10(1) प्रसु./अनु.-1/2012).

This Court directs respondent/competent authority to consider the representation of the petitioner, if filed, and decide the same within a period of thirty days, strictly in accordance with law, expeditiously as per the ratio encapsulated in **Pawan Meena (Supra)** and Circular dated 19.02.2024.

4. In light of the aforestated, the present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty being granted. It is made clear that petitioner is at liberty to approach appropriate forum, if *lis* in question still survives.
