This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.79/2026 registered at Police Station Bilara, District Jodhpur Rural, for offences under Section 8/18 of the NDPS Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the contraband recovered from him is 1 kg 326 gram opium which is below commercial quantity. It is further submitted that criminal antecedents against the petitioner are clear. Learned counsel submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.04.2026 and investigation is complete in the matter and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submission of the parties as well as facts and circumstances of the case. In the present case, contraband recovered from him is 1 kg 326 gram opium which is below commercial quantity and his criminal antecedents are clear. The petitioner is behind the bars since 17.04.2026 and the investigation from him has already been completed.

Hence, keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Bhanwar Lal S/o Shri Shankar Lal**, arrested in connection with FIR No.79/2026 registered at Police Station Bilara, District Jodhpur Rural, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
