The present second bail application under Section 483 BNSS
(439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioners who has been

arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.32/2026 registered at Police Station Surpalia, District Nagaur, for offences under Sections 189(2), 115(2), 117(2), 126(2), 110, 324(2) and 61(2) BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present case the injury has been assigned to Ram Kishor. Further the *lathi* has already been recovered from Mukesh. So far as the petitioners are concerned nothing has been recovered from them. The Statement of Ramswaroop states that Gajadhar and Dinesh were not at the spot. He submits that charge-sheet has already been filed and investigation from petitioners is complete and petitioner are behind the bars since 06.04.2026. The trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record. In the present case the injury has not been assigned to the petitioners. Further the *lathi* has already been recovered from Mukesh, and nothing has been recovered from the petitioners. Further, there presence is doubtful. The charge-sheet has already been filed and investigation from petitioners is complete and petitioner are behind the bars since 06.04.2026.

Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, and that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail;

but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners **Gajjadhar Alias Gajanand S/o Bhopal Ram** and **Dinesh S/o Shaitanram** arrested in connection with FIR No.32/2026 registered at Police Station Surpaliya, District Nagaur, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
