1. The present writ petition has been preferred seeking grant of emergent parole on humanitarian ground on account of marriage of the petitioner's brother which is going to be solemnized on 24.06.2026. The petitioner's father is a heart patient and undergoing medical treatment, therefore all the functions are to be performed by him. A prayer has, therefore, been made for his release on emergent parole.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-State has opposed the petition.



3. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel representing the State and have perused the material made available to this court.

4. Rule 10A of the Rajasthan Prisoners Release on Parole Rules provides for grant of emergent parole in cases involving humanitarian considerations.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and taking a humanitarian view of the matter, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner deserves to be released on emergent parole for a period of seven days.

6. Accordingly, the instant parole writ petition is allowed and it is ordered that the convict-petitioner **Naresh Kumar S/o Shri Karma Ram** shall be released on emergent parole of **7 days** upon furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of Superintendent Central Jail, Jodhpur on the usual terms and conditions. The Superintendent Central Jail, Jodhpur shall be at liberty to impose other adequate and reasonable conditions to ensure return of the convict to the custody after availing the emergent parole. The term of emergent parole shall be computed from the date of his actual release.
