Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2.

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner who claims to be the brother of the corpus Mst."P" and is stated to be in the illegal detention of respondent No.4.

In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, Mst."P" has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst."P" and she has stated before us that she is 25 years of age and has acquired the qualification of B.Sc., B.Ed. She has stated that since the petitioner was threatening her and was keeping her under pressure, therefore she left the parental house and started living at Ahmedabad with her friend Manisha Katara. She has stated that she is doing job at Ahmedabad and is living happily with her friend Manisha Katara. She has also lodged a complaint at Police Station Anandpuri anticipating certain untoward incident at the hands of her family members including petitioner. She has expressed her desire of going and living with her friend at Ahmedabad and for doing her job.

5. We have considered the statements made before us and we are convinced that Mst."P" is not in the illegal detention of any person including respondent No.4. Since, she is an educated major person, therefore, she is free to live at a place of her own choice. The writ petition, therefore, fails and the same is hereby dismissed.

6. The Investigating Agency is therefore directed that Mst."P" should not suffer any threat to her body or person at the hands of petitioner and she may be taken to Ahmedabad by providing adequate security.
