This application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) has been filed by the
petitioner, who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.
134/2026 registered at Police Station Loonkaransar, District
Bikaner, for the offence under Section 303(2) of the Bharatiya
Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public
Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offence
alleged against the petitioner is triable by a Court of Magistrate. It
is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the
petitioner and only one other criminal case is stated to be pending
against him. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in

judicial custody since 04.05.2026 and that the trial of the case is likely to take considerable time; therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record. The offence alleged against the petitioner is triable by a Court of Magistrate. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioner and, as submitted, only one other criminal case is pending against him. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.05.2026. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the nature of the accusation, the fact that the offence is triable by a Magistrate, the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, and considering that the conclusion of the trial is likely to take considerable time, this Court is of the view that the petitioner has made out a case for grant of bail. Nothing has been brought on record to indicate that, if enlarged on bail, the petitioner would abscond or misuse the liberty granted to him. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of the BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of the BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner, Sohail Khan S/o Jakir Khan, arrested in connection with FIR No. 134/2026 registered at Police Station Loonkaransar, District

Bikaner, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided that he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- along with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, for his appearance before the said Court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so, till conclusion of the trial.
