For the reasons mentioned in the application (I.A. No.01/2026), the same is, therefore, allowed.

The delay in filing the present criminal revision petition is condone.

Issue notice.

S.B. Criminal Misc. Application for Suspension of Sentence
No.217/2026:-

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner-applicant and the learned Public Prosecutor on the application for suspension of sentence.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and upon consideration of the material available on record, particularly keeping in view the fact that the petitioner-applicant who was convicted for imprisonment of one year has already remained in judicial custody for more than five months and that the present criminal revision petition is not likely to be heard in the near future owing to the heavy pendency of criminal revision petitions before this Court, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case for suspending the sentence awarded to the petitioner-applicant during the pendency of the revision petition.

Accordingly, the application for suspension of sentence filed under Section 397/401 Cr.P.C. (438/442 BNSS) is allowed and it is ordered that the sentences passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Jaisalmer in Criminal Misc. Case No.267/2017 vide order dated 07.11.2022 as affirmed by the learned Session Judge, Jaisalmer vide order dated 07.04.2025 passed in Criminal Appeal No.29/2022 against the petitioner-applicant **Narendra Bharti S/o Kishan Bharti**, shall remain suspended till final disposal of the aforesaid revision and he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for her appearance in this court on **10.08.2026** and

whenever ordered to do so, till the disposal of the revision on the conditions indicated below:-

1. That he/she/they will appear before the trial Court in the month of January of every year till the revision is decided.
2. That if the applicant(s) changes the place of residence, he/she/they will give in writing his/her/their changed address to the trial Court as well as to the counsel in the High Court.
3. Similarly, if the sureties change their address(s), they will give in writing their changed address to the trial Court.

The learned trial Court shall keep the record of attendance of the accused-applicant(s) in a separate file. Such file be registered as Criminal Misc. Case related to original case in which the accused-applicant(s) was/were tried and convicted. A copy of this order shall also be placed in that file for ready reference. Criminal Misc. file shall not be taken into account for statistical purpose relating to pendency and disposal of cases in the trial court. In case the said accused applicant(s) does not appear before the trial court, the learned trial Judge shall report the matter to the High Court for cancellation of bail.
